Jim Tomaszewski called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

Jim Lehan moved to appoint William Conklin to the Municipal Housing Trust Committee, term to expire 6/30/12. Rob Garrity seconded and it was **so voted**.

Jim Lehan moved to appoint Thomas Cleverdon to the Municipal Housing Trust Committee, as the seventh member, term to expire 6/30/14. Rob Garrity seconded and it was **so voted**.

Rob Garrity moved to approve the Norfolk Lions Club/Recreation Santa's Parade for Sunday, December 4, 2012 at 2:45 p.m. Jim Tomaszewski recused himself as he is a member of the Lions Club. Jim Lehan seconded and it was **so voted**.

The Board discussed adopting the House Bill 1972. Shawn Dooley said it was moot – it is going to have to be moved again. Rob disagreed and said he is opposed to adopting it. It changes the state primary date back to June. There was much discussion back and forth, and Rob was against it still, but Jim L. and Jim T. were okay.

The Board discussed the status of the Café Pesto liquor license. The Board agreed that we are going into five years without the license being active. They agreed to hold a public hearing. Jack will send Peter Chipman a letter outlining the process for a hearing.

At 6:30 p.m., being no further business, Rob Garrity moved to adjourn the meeting. Jim Lehan seconded, and it was **so voted**.
