
The duly posted meeting of the Norfolk Conservation Commission convened at 5:00 P.M. on-site at 84 Cleveland Street, Norfolk.

**SITE VISIT:**

**84 Cleveland Street, Lakeland Farms, Comprehensive Permit, NOI, #240-577 - Present were Ted O’Harte, Stephen O’Connell, Dave Crossman, Lenore White**

Mr. Weddleton began by stating that this site visit was scheduled so that Commission members could get a look at the property, in order to better understand the remaining areas of discussion between both teams’ wetlands scientists. The visit began with the intermittent stream at the front of the property, and the wetland scientists exchanged questions and comments as to the source, and the definition and classification of a “stream.” Source areas across the street were visited. The area around the well was visited and discussed, again with questions and comments as to the source of the water. The area classified as “land under water” was visited, with much discussion regarding banks and BVW. Both sides will write up criteria with regard to CMR 310, s. 10.54.
