Mr. Norton seconded the motion; the vote on the motion was 5-0.

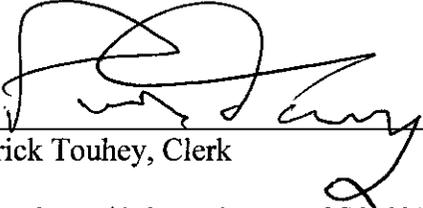
170 Berkshire Street – NOI #240-170, Maple Park Estates Request for Certificate of Release (COR)
