- **25 Myrtle St. – #240-580** – Christopher & Rebecca Cali, Amend OOC or minor revision (backyard fence installed) – Ms. Cali explained that they installed the fence due to having a young child and a dog, and a heavily wooded backyard. They were unaware of any restriction at that point, as the builder never communicated that there was an Order of Conditions on the property. After discussion with the Agent, Ms. Lauria informed Ms. Cali that the fence could perhaps be moved outside of the 50’ buffer zone, but within the 50-100’ buffer zone, and a new plan would have to be filed with the Commission. Discussion ensued with regard to hydroseeding, and Ms. Cali was advised to wait until after a determination was made on the fence.
