NEW/OLD BUSINESS/CORRESPONDENCE:

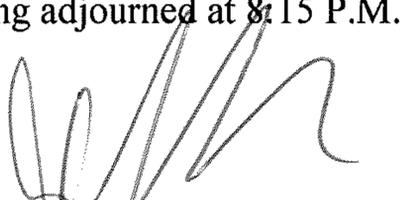
- BOH Fishing Locations – Ms. DeLonga said she sent suggestions on where to place signs to the BOH
