4th Quarter Tax Payment Deadline Extended to June 1, 2020

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic the State passed a bill (H4617) signed by Governor Baker, enabling the Select Board to exercise an option to extend the 4th quarter Real Estate and Personal Property tax bill due date from May 1, 2020 to June 1, 2020. The Board voted unanimously for this extension on April 7th.

***What does this mean for tax payers?**

- For those tax payers that are currently signed up for automatic payments through the Town's online payment system (Unipay) that payment for May 1st will be processed as scheduled. If you are on AutoPay but you would like to take advantage of the extension, you must **cancel** your AutoPay **by April 24th**. You may then go online on May 4th, when an updated file is uploaded, and schedule a future payment to be made by June 1, 2020.

Please note: after that future payment is scheduled you must sign-up for AutoPay for future payments.

- Online payments cannot be scheduled after May 1st at this time however for those tax payers not on AutoPay but would like to schedule an online payment for June 1st you may do so as of May 4, 2020.

***What about those who do not pay online?**

The options to make payments include:

- Use our online payment system at www.norfolk.ma.us
- Mail your bill with remittance in the envelope enclosed with your bill
- Drop off check and bill in the secured drop box at the parking lot entrance of Town Hall

As a reminder, partial payments for Real Estate, Personal Property taxes and Water bills are accepted at any time.

Please remember, Town Hall is currently closed to the public, therefore we cannot accept CASH payments.
