Re: Request for Speed Surveys

Dear Board of Selectmen:

Pursuant to numerous requests from residents of the Town of Norfolk, this correspondence serves as an official request by the Norfolk Road Safety Committee to survey speed limits within town boundaries for specific street locations. As this request falls under the jurisdiction of the Board of Selectmen as a potential modification to the Town's Rules and Orders, we respectfully request your authorization to survey the following streets at a minimum of two (2) separate intervals on each street as determined by the Norfolk Highway Department.

Requested Street Surveys:

- 1) Medway Street
- 2) Union Street
- 3) Myrtle Street

The RSC has reviewed numerous requests and have targeted the above streets as an initial effort to review speed limits within the town. It appears the current rules and orders for the town concerning established speed limits were ratified in the early 1950s when clearly town demographics were drastically different.

The RSC's guiding principal is to promote proper and safe conveyance throughout the town for its residents, businesses, and patrons. As such, we welcome the anticipated support of the Board of Selectmen, concerning this request for speed surveys, to help achieve this goal.
