



## **Norfolk Historical Commission - History Scholarship Opportunity for the 2016 - 17 Academic Year**

The Norfolk Historical Commission is pleased to announce the opportunity for college students to apply for the NHC History Scholarship in the amount of \$500.00 to help defray the cost of tuition. Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the college/university where the recipient is enrolled. In order to apply, the candidate must meet all qualifications and follow the application process detailed below.

### **Qualifications of the applicant in order to be eligible:**

- was a resident of Norfolk, Massachusetts while attending Norfolk schools
- completed six (6) years attending Norfolk Schools with at least two of those years in Norfolk Elementary Schools. The remaining four years of the six year requirement may include a combination of King Philip Middle and High Schools.
- must be currently enrolled in a four year program at an accredited academic institution
- majoring in a program in historic preservation, historical research, archaeology, or a related field of history and has successfully completed at least two years of a four year program

### **Application Process - The applicant must:**

- submit the application by April 30th of their sophomore and/or junior year in college
- include an official current transcript of at least the first three semesters
- include two letters of reference from teachers and/or professors attesting to the student's qualifications
- submit an essay (500 words) by the applicant detailing the reasons for selecting a history related program of study
- send the completed application, college transcript, 2 letters of reference, and essay to
